| Cornus florida         | Flowering dogwood   | 15x20             | Medium      | Partial Shade             | Yes                  | White flowers                                | Susceptible to dogwood anthracnose  |
| Crataegus viridis      | Hawthorn            | 35x35             | Fast        | Full sun                  | No                   | White, fragrant flowers; Pollinator friendly | Tolerant of urban pollution; Select a thornless variety: such as 'Winter King'  |
| Diospyros virginiana   | Persimmon           | 50x30             | Medium      | Full Sun to Shade         | No                   | White flowers and large fruit                |   |
| Fagus grandifolia      | American beech      | 40x50             | Slow        | Full sun to Partial Shade | No                   | Smooth bark                                  | Prefers uncompacted soils   |
| Gleditsia triacanthos  | Honeylocust         | 70x60             | Fast        | Full sun                  | No                   | Large seedpods and white flowers             | Select a thornless cultivar   |
| Gymnocladus dioicus    | Kentucky coffeetree | 70x45             | Medium      | Full sun                  | No                   | Large compound leaves with up to 14 leaflets | Seed pods are not edible  |

| Liquidambar styraciflua | Sweetgum            | 50x75             | Medium      | Full sun to Partial Shade | No                   | Star shaped leaves and orange fall color    | Select a seedless cultivar                   |
| Liriodendron tulipifera | Tuliptree           | 75x50             | Medium      | Full sun to Partial Shade | No                   | Tulip shaped flowers and leaves             |  |
| Magnolia grandiflora    | Southern magnolia   | 70x40             | Medium      | Full sun to Partial Shade | No                   | Evergreen with white flowers                |  |
| Magnolia virginiana     | Sweetbay magnolia   | 30x25             | Medium      | Full sun to Partial Shade | No                   | Semi-evergreen with white flowers           |  |
| Malus angustifolia      | Southern crabapple  | 30x20             | Medium      | Full sun                  | No                   | White flowers                               | Fruit is susceptible to Cedar Apple Rust     |
| Nyssa sylvatica         | Blackgum            | 50x30             | Fast        | Full sun to Partial Shade | No                   | Nice fall color and fruit attracts wildlife | Prefers moist, acidic soil                   |
| Ostrya virginiana       | Eastern hophornbeam | 30x20             | Slow        | Partial sun to Shade      | Yes                  | Hop-shaped fruit                            |  |
| Oxydendrum arboreum     | Sourwood            | 40x20             | Slow        | Full sun to Partial Shade | No                   | Nice fall color and white flowers           |  |
| Quercus alba            | White oak           | 70x70             | Slow        | Full sun to Partial Shade | No                   | Acorns and nice fall color                  |  |
| Quercus bicolor         | Swamp white oak     | 60x50             | Medium      | Full sun to Partial Shade | No                   | Acorns and nice fall color                  |  |
| Quercus macrocarpa      | Bur oak             | 80x80             | Slow        | Full sun                  | No                   | Unique acorn and leaves                     |  |
