#### Road Turnout

- Roads should follow the contour where possible with grades between 2 to 10 percent (2-10%).
- Keep roads away from streamside management zones.
- Avoid roads that go straight up and down the grade use switchbacks on steeper grades.
- Roads require maintenance during use.
- Sometimes the best idea is to abandon an entrenched road for a new one.
- Access should be controlled (gate).



### Brushed Road

- Where possible, skidding should be dispersed to prevent concentrated trails.
- Avoid skidding straight up and down slopes if at all possible.
- Brush should be used whenever possible to prevent erosion, eliminate the need for excessive BMPs and prevent rutting and soil compaction.
