### NOTICE OF GOOD NEIGHBOR AUTHORITY TIMBER SALE

Bids/offers will be received for the purchase of all timber (sawtimber and pulpwood) estimated for harvest on the designated portion of the <u>George Washington and Jefferson National Forests – Warm Springs/James River (USFS-WSJR)</u>, located off State Route 18 approximately six (6) miles northeast of Paint Bank and approximately 22 miles northwest out of Covington on Highway 18 to Sweet Road – FS #350 and approximately two miles northwest along Forest Service #350 to the start of the first unit (14) in Allegheny County. See attached maps. Hard copy bids will be received by the Virginia Department of Forestry, Attention: Ed Stoots, 210 Riverland Drive, Salem, VA 24153, until 10:00 a.m., July 10, 2024. Bids/offers may also be emailed to <u>timbersales@dof.virginia.gov</u> at any point prior to the due date. At the date and time stated, all bids received will be evaluated and awarded to the Purchaser with the highest total bid value/offer for the various products.

The timber sale area contains approximately 136.9 acres in nine (9) units (7A, 7B, 8A, 8B, 9,10,11,12, 14), consisting of pine and hardwood timber (see Attachment A, B, & C). All sawtimber and standing pulpwood is estimated and scheduled for harvest cutting under this contract except those designated for leave in orange paint or those within marked SMZ's in blue paint. The timber sale boundary is marked with pink/orange flagging and orange vertical paint stripes. Ingress and egress shall be only through Forest Service Property as shown on Attachment A. All logging activity will be confined to the sale area and any logging debris accumulated outside the sale area, including the reserve strips, must be pulled back inside the sale area. Stump height shall not exceed 10 inches above mineral soil.

All sawtimber and pulpwood sized trees to remove within the sale area have been cruised. All merchantable timber <u>except those designated for leave marked in orange paint</u> are to be harvested within the 136.9 acres and within the sale area. SMZs are marked in blue paint and there is no harvesting within the SMZs.

The following volumes are only estimates and not guaranteed. Each bidder is encouraged to use their own cruise data to compute bids.

Haul roads on Forest Service numbered roads shall be always maintained in accordance with the road maintenance requirements listed in Attachment 1.

All bids will be submitted on a stumpage price per ton for pine and hardwood pulpwood and a stumpage price per MBF International ¼" Rule for mixed pine and mixed hardwood sawtimber. The stumpage prices will be multiplied by the estimated pulpwood volumes and sawtimber volumes and then added together to create a total combined bid value. The sale will be awarded to the highest total combined bid value. The written bid must be quoted to two decimal places (\$0.00/ton) or (\$0.00/MBF). The Department reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

### Example:

**Hypothetical Bid Estimated Volume Combined Bid Computation** 

Hardwood and Pine Pulpwood: \$5.00/ton x 4,037 tons = \$20,185.00

Mixed Pine Sawtimber: \$20.00/MBF International 1/4" Rule x 91.44 MBF = \$1,828.80

Mixed Hardwood Sawtimber: \$50/MBF International 1/4" Rule x 341.96 MBF = \$17,098.00

Total Combined Bid = \$39,111.80

All bids/offers will be on a per unit basis for the timber offered with additional payment required for trees harvested that were not designated for removal. Bids/offers will be as stated on the bid sheet. <a href="Deposits are no longer required with a timber sale bid.">Deposits are no longer required with a timber sale bid.</a> Only the winning bidder will be required to submit a deposit. A two thousand five-hundred-dollar (\$2,500) deposit will be required when the signed contracts are returned along with an advance payment for the timber sale. The deposit must be in the form of a check made payable to the Treasurer of Virginia, Department of Forestry. The deposit will serve as a performance bond and be retained until satisfactory conclusion of the contract by the successful bidder, at which time it will be released. The Department reserves the right to reject any and all bids/offers.

The Purchaser will be required to make a down payment of \$9,500 within ten (10) business days of the bid date. The down payment will be held by the Department through the majority of the sale until the expected value of the remaining timber to be harvested is equal to the amount of the down payment. Payments for purchased timber shall be on the basis of actual volume removed as evidenced by individual load tickets, mill tickets, or similar documentation. Volume documentation and stumpage checks made payable to "Treasurer of Virginia, Department of Forestry" will be submitted to the State Lands Manager, Virginia Department of Forestry, P.O. Box 100, Salem, VA 24153, on a weekly basis throughout the entirety of the harvest. The down payment will be applied as a stumpage payment near the end of harvesting operations when the expected remaining stumpage value is equal to the amount of the down payment. In the event the down payment exceeds the remaining stumpage balance, a refund will be issued to the Purchaser. In the event the down payment is less than the remaining stumpage value, the Purchaser will continue weekly stumpage payments and load documentation until the full balance is received.

### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Be sure to enter your complete and correct address.
- 2. All bids will be on the basis of price quotes per ton (\$0.00/ton) for pine and hardwood pulpwood and price quotes per MBF International ¼" Rule (\$0.00/MBF) for pine and hardwood sawtimber. Carry all bid quotations to two decimal places. The total combined value based on an estimated **4,037 tons** of pine and hardwood pulpwood and **91.44 MBF** International ¼" Rule for pine sawtimber and **341.96 MBF** International ¼" Rule for hardwood sawtimber will be used to determine the winning bid.
- 3. Deposits are no longer required at the time of bid/offer submittal. A two thousand five-hundred-dollar (\$2,500) deposit made payable to Treasurer of Virginia; Department of Forestry will be required from the winning bidder at the signing of the contract. The deposit will serve as a performance bond and be retained until satisfactory conclusion of the contract by the successful bidder, at which time it will be released.
- 4. For hand delivery or conventional mail delivery, seal your proposal in an envelope marked as follows: "BID for Timber Sale on Potts Creek GNA Kyles Branch Units. DUE: July 10, 2024 at 10:00 AM." Please write your name on the envelope if dropping off or mailing, "Bid Proposed by: (Name)." Enclose dropped off or mailed bids in an envelope addressed to Virginia Department of Forestry, 210 Riverland Drive, P.O. Box 100, Salem, VA 24153.
- 5. If emailing your bid, send the bid form to timbersales@dof.virginia.gov. All emailed bids must have the following in the subject line: "BID for the Timber Sale on the Potts Creek GNA Kyles Branch Units. DUE: July 10, 2024, at 10:00 a.m."
- 6. Gravel requirements are listed on Attachment 1 in the DRAFT Contract, and they are the minimum requirements for tons and type of gravel.
- 7. Be sure your bid/offer form is signed and delivered, mailed, or emailed in time to reach Salem or Ed Stoots well **before 10:00 a.m., July 10, 2024. NO LATE BIDS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

I agree that the awarding of said contract shall be to the Purchaser submitting the highest combined bid per ton for pine & hardwood pulpwood and mixed hardwood & pine sawtimber. In case of identical bids, final determination will be by drawing restricted to those parties of identical bids. I also understand that the Department of Forestry reserves the right to reject any and all bids. A **two thousand five-hundred-dollar** (\$2,500) deposit/performance bond made payable to **Treasurer of Virginia**, **Department of Forestry**, will be required when the signed contracts are returned. The deposit will serve as a performance bond and will be retained until satisfactory conclusion of the contract by the successful bidder, at which time it will be released. If the successful bidder fails to execute the contract in the prescribed time period or perform services to the standards outlined in the contract, in addition to all other legal remedies available, the deposit will be forfeited to the Department. If this bid is accepted, I agree to pay the \$9,500.00 timber sale deposit for the offered timber with ten (10) business days of the bid acceptance date I have read the sample contract to be signed if my bid is accepted,

A Purchaser is in default if their bid is accepted, and they fail to abide by their agreement to purchase the timber as offered. Debarment, suspension, or rejection of future bids by the Department may result from such default.



## USFS Potts Creek GNA 3--Kyles Branch Location






### ATTACHMENT B SALE MAP – AERIAL








### ATTACHMENT C SALE MAP – TOPO
