The Virginia state nurseries are members of the Cooperative Tree Improvement Program at North Carolina State University. Enhanced productivity through breeding, selecting and deploying superior loblolly pine families is a major goal of the Cooperative.

Benefits of Tree Improvement Research

- Due to cooperative sharing of genetic material, the best families suitable for Virginia are grown at DOF nurseries.
- Selections continuously place emphasis on properties desirable for solid wood products (e.g., straightness and crown characteristics).
- Some families from other provenances and cold hardiness zones either perform erratically or fail in Virginia.

Advantages of Our Improved Loblolly Pine

- Improved genetics for fast-growing, straight and disease-resistant seedlings
- Increased growth and yield over unimproved seedlings based upon field trials [Loblolly Pine Premium Open Pollinated (OP) provides minimum 50% gain; Loblolly Pine Elite Open Pollinated (OP) provides minimum 60% gain; Loblolly Pine Virginia's Best Open Pollinated (OP) provides minimum 65% gain, and Loblolly Pine Control Pollinated (CP) provides minimum 90% gain]

- Completely dormant seedlings withstand shipment and planting significantly better than non-dormant seedlings

Terms and Conditions

- A refund will be granted with a \$20 service fee deducted when the landowner cancels the order within 30 days of placing the order.
- A refund will be granted with a 50% restocking fee or \$20 service fee (whichever is higher) when the landowner cancels the order between 31 to 59 days after placing the order.
- A refund will be granted with a 90% restocking fee or \$20 service fee (whichever is higher) when the landowner cancels the order after 60 days of placing the order and before January 15.
- No refunds after February 1.

The Virginia Department of Forestry (DOF) has been growing seedlings for Virginia landowners for more than 100 years. The cultural practices that we use in growing seedlings in our seedbeds are based on more than 60 years of research and experience in quality production.

In addition to a wide selection of bare-root seedlings, we also offer specialty seedling packs suitable for various wildlife habitats. Most seedlings are sold directly from the seedbed without replanting, and seedling age is indicated with 1-0, 2-0 and 3-0 (one-, two- and three-year-old).

Sussex Nursery Offers Containerized Longleaf Pine



Containerized seedlings help accelerate early growth on pine plantations. Due to cold weather, the best time to plant bareroot seedlings in Virginia is February to March. However, container seedlings are best planted in the fall. Pristine roots, larger seedling size, intact root ball and earlier planting all contribute to rapid growth.

All container seedlings will be packaged by November 1 and must be picked up by mid-December.

To Place an Order

- Orders are accepted from October to mid-April.
- Order online at www.BuyVaTrees.com; by mail using Form 12.2 Tree Seedling Catalog Order available at www.dof.virginia.gov, or by phone at (540) 363-7000.
- Payment in full is required at time of order.

Shipping and Handling

- Seedlings are available for pick-up or delivery from February 20 to April 26 depending on weather conditions.
- Pick-up is available at the Augusta Nursery freeof-charge.
- Shipping charge is 35% of the order total with a minimum shipping charge of \$25.
- Specify a desired shipment date when placing order.
- All UPS orders are shipped from the Augusta Nursery on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays.

Sales Tax

• Virginia sales tax is 5.3% of the order subtotal.

Tax Exempt

- ◆ Tax-exempt orders CANNOT be made online through the web store. For tax-exempt orders, mail a completed Form 12.2 Tree Seedling Catalog Order with a completed sales tax exemption form to the Augusta Nursery with payment. Sales tax exemption form must be completed in full, including tax exempt number. Blank sales tax exemption forms can be found at tax.virginia.gov.
- → Walnut trees are susceptible to Thousand Cankers Disease, which has been found in Virginia. See DOF website for additional information.
- → This species may be upgraded to "Whips" to meet the standards for Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program plantings. Available in limited quantities.
