Sap (Gums & Resins)

Sap contains water, mineral elements, hormones and other nutrients. We think of maple syrup, but it is also used in latex, medicines, adhesives, gum and more.

Wood Pulp

Cellulose is a major component of wood and is used in many products: all types of paper, cardboard, diapers and food additives to thicken, prevent caking or add fiber.
