Forest Resource Management (Dean Cumbia)

- Forest Management Academies East and West coming up. Both are classes are full.
- Forest Sustainability Fund was established to help offset land use revenue.
 - Survey went out to ask localities if they are interested in participating in the Forest Sustainability Fund, closes on Friday, September 9.
 - The application for localities to apply for forest sustainability funds will open in October and close in November.
 - Guidelines are due October 15.
 - Responses are due November 15.
 - The hardwood tax credit is moving forward.
